Map guidelines for MORP database: place tree ID in the grid. Use a 7 digit tree ID starting with 3 letters of the orchard owner last name (or previous owner or other to avoid duplicate combinations, keep track) followed by grid coordinates. For example kena005 or kenb010 (owner Kenyon)

Map guidelines for Norwood group: begin each tree ID with the number 1 followed by two letter owner initials (avoid duplicates) to make 7 digit ID. For example, 1jna001 (owner Jennifer Nelson from Norwood). Keep a good log to check before mapping to avoid duplicate 3 digit beginnings. This 3 digit “orchard abbreviation” links trees to proper orchard number in database.
